

# Terms and Conditions

## Photomathon Llandudno 17

1. Carry your registration card/wrist band with you at all times for duration of the competition.
2. This event takes place in the public realm. Please ensure you exercise due care and diligence. Do not risk your health and safety for the sake of taking a photograph!
3. Minors 16-18 years can only participate with parental consent, children younger than 16 are required to be accompanied by an adult. The adult should be their legal parent or guardian. If parents/guardians wish their child to participate accompanied by another responsible adult, they will need to fill in a consent form nominating that person.
4. This is a family event, please keep this in mind when taking your photos and keep the images you create suitable for viewing by all. Any image deemed inappropriate will be disqualified from the event. This includes photos reflecting pornography, hate speech, representations of violence or discrimination.
5. CALL (CIC) and LLawn reserves the right to use any images entered into the event to promote Photomathon Llandudno or any of our future events. Photographers retain all rights to their images in all other aspects.
6. Access to camera memory card and smartphones are a requirement of Photomathon Llandudno. It is the responsibility of the owner to ensure that their cameras, smartphones and all equipment are suitably insured. We accept no liability for any damage to equipment.
7. In order to upload the images from your smartphone we will need to access your phone via USB cable. Make sure any images that are private are not able to be accessed. We recommend the removal of all images from your smartphone before you arrive to register.
8. You will need an empty memory card if photographing with a digital camera. We will upload images from the card using a card reader.
9. Please remember that a person or persons who are the SOLE FOCUS of a photo must give you their permission to photograph them and for us to publish their photo in an exhibition. Please be sensitive about who and what you photograph.
10. Only JPG formats will be accepted. Please be sure that your camera has been set on "high quality" JPG format and photo format. Smartphones will do this automatically.
11. Should you want to take RAW photos as well, please make sure your camera takes JPG and RAW photos at the same time. We will not have time or capacity at the end station to make any conversions. Your series risks being excluded from the competition if you only shoot RAW. If you shoot RAW and JPG, our software will just read and download the JPGs.
12. Over 18s: If you make it to the Finish line by 6pm on the 17th June 2017 AND all 8 photos are in consecutive order and unedited on your memory card, then you have made it! Remember: There must only be 8 photos on the card, otherwise you will be disqualified. Under 18s: If you make it back by 2pm with 4 photos, unedited, in the right order YOU have made it! If you wish to stay on and take more pictures you can.
13. We do not issue refunds on registration payments.
14. We reserve the right to alter these Rules at any time. If the alterations constitute a material change to the Rules, we will notify you via e-mail according to the email address you provided at the time of registration.
